

Book Launch on Saturday February 19th



Kay Brown, Falkirk's latest author, read extracts from her book 'Come, See This Man' a series of meditations for Lent and Easter' to a packed hall in the Falkirk Christian Centre at an event hosted by Falkirk Christian Bookshop. Rev Melville Crosthwaite, minister at Larbert East Church of Scotland, introduced Kay who has had a varied career as a nurse, a mother and a teacher prior to becoming a Lay Reader with the Church of Scotland and he wished her well in this new chapter of her life.

Kay shared with all who were there how the book had come into being. She had been asked to lead a service which was to be more informal and that is why the first meditation was written and as time went on she found that this format was suitable in many more situations. People began to ask her which book the meditations had come from and when they heard that they were her own work she was encouraged to have them printed.

Kay captivated her audience with inspirational renderings of her work. Her husband John also read one of the mediations. The audience spent time at the end of the meeting talking with Kay as she signed their copies of her book.
